The Power of Vision Community Mural Project (POV) is a project-based community mural program of Hope Community, established in 2004. POV uses mural creation as an avenue for developing artistic skills, leadership, and community relationships. POV is a training ground for artists, centering indigenous artists and other artists of color to gain experience and mentorship in working with community members to produce high quality public art.


In 2024, Hope celebrated the 20th anniversary of the Power of Vision. What began as a small group of young graffiti artists under the leadership of Chaka Mkali has grown into an enduring pillar of Hope's community engagement work, creating more than 30 murals and providing opportunities for hundreds of community members to develop their skills as artists and leaders. POV is grounded in the belief that process matters as much as the final mural. This is one of the sustaining ways Hope's legacy of Placekeeping is carried out —recognizing and uplifting the art and culture that already exists in our community and resisting displacement by preserving cultural memory.


